The Junior League of Omaha was founded in 1919 and is dedicated to promoting voluntarism and improving communities through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. The Volunteer Scholarship was established in 1992 to support the volunteer and leadership potential of our youth. The Junior League of Omaha awards one scholarship in the amount of \$3,000 to a female high school senior who demonstrate outstanding volunteer performance in the community.

Candidates who would like to apply for a Junior League of Omaha Volunteer Scholarship must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be a young woman graduating from an Omaha area high school.
2. Must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4 point scale.
3. Must enroll as a fulltime student in any private or public postsecondary institution in the upcoming school year.
4. Must be involved in a volunteer capacity in the community.
5. Volunteer work must be additional from any that is required by school or church.

Application Procedures:

1. Complete the Application, including the Personal Statement and Supervisor Recommendation Form. The Application must be completed in its entirety – all questions must be answered.
2. Submit your application to the Junior League of Omaha.

Applications must be postmarked no later than March 6, 2010.
